Council's direction: Bring back the item to April study session with cost estimate for conversion the entire parcel to passive park and installation of modular building, revenue estimate from modular building, and input from PD regarding safety and access concerns

Council's direction: bring back to a regular council meeting a policy establishing directions for citywide neighborhood identification signs, which should be uniform throughout the community, and establish an Ad Hoc Committee to work on sign designs and identifying cost for installation and long-term maintenance

 5. Summary of Draft Route 60 Corridor Master Plan for Aesthetic and Landscaping at State Route 60/Moreno Beach Drive Interchange and Nason Street Overcrossing - Project No. 07-41570024 (Public Works Department/ 10 Min.)
Council's direction: define "Gateway" as first and last interchange to the City (Gilman Springs Road and Day Street); leave March Air Force base theme for 215 corridor
 6. Discussion to Reduce FY 10/11 City Council Discretionary Funds (Flickinger/Batey/ 10 Min.) ❖
Council's direction: decrease each Council discretionary fund to \$2,000 for FY 2010/2011
 7. Discussion Regarding Letter of Hardship to Southern California Edison (Flickinger/Batey/ 10 Min.) ❖
Council's direction: Approved sending a letter of hardship to SCE
