### **RECOMMENDED ACTION**

#### **Recommendation:**

1. Staff recommends that the City Council adopt Resolution 2020 – establishing the existence of a local emergency due to COVID-19 virus pandemic.

### **SUMMARY**

This report recommends adoption of a Resolution declaring the existence of a local emergency in the City of Moreno Valley due to the Covid-19 Virus Pandemic.

### **DISCUSSION**

The world-wide outbreak of the coronavirus (Covid-19) resulted in a declaration of a pandemic by the World Health Organization last week. This was followed by similar urgency declarations from the federal government, Governor Newsom and the State of California as well as the County of Riverside.

Adoption of the proposed Resolution would confirm the actions taken by the other agencies and establish the existence of the local emergency in the City of Moreno Valley. The declaration will also put the City in a better position to recover from the State and Federal governments any emergency relief funding to cover the fiscal impacts of this pandemic on our budget.

Moreno Valley Municipal Code Chapter 2.40 addresses the emergency management organization and function. Consistent with MVMC Section 2.40.060 City Manager as the Director of emergency services is empowered to take all necessary steps to protect the health and safety of our residents and employees. City Council and staff in

collaboration with other effected agencies and school districts has, from the beginning, spearheaded all efforts to minimize the effects of the Covid-19 virus on our community. This Resolution is yet another step in that direction.

## **ALTERNATIVES**

1. Adopt the Resolution 2020- declaring the existence of a local emergency.
2. Provide alternate direction to staff.

## **FISCAL IMPACT**

Adoption of this Resolution will have a positive fiscal impact, as it will provide the platform for reimbursement from the State and Federal governments of funds expanded by the City

**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF MORENO VALLEY, CALIFORNIA  
PROCLAIMING EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY  
DUE TO THE COVID-19 VIRUS PANDEMIC**

**WHEREAS**, California Government Code Section 8630 and Section 2.40.060 of the City of Moreno Valley Municipal Code (MVMC) empower the City Council of the City of Moreno Valley to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency if said city is affected by an emergency as defined in the California Government Code Section 8558; and

**WHEREAS**, conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property have arisen within this city caused by the Covid-19 Virus Pandemic, which endangers the health and welfare of the residents and visitors of the City of Moreno Valley; and

**WHEREAS**, the aforesaid conditions of extreme peril warrant and necessitate the proclamation of the existence of a local emergency.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MORENO VALLEY PROCLAIMS** that a local emergency now exists throughout said City; and

**IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED** that during the existence of said local emergency the powers, function, and duties of the Director of Emergency Services and the emergency organization of the City shall be those prescribed by state law, and by ordinance and resolutions of the City in effect as of this date.

**IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED** that said local emergency shall be deemed to continue to exist until its termination is proclaimed by the City Council of the City of Moreno Valley, State of California.
